Please join us for a visit to the Wolfe's Neck Center for Agriculture & the Environment Dairy Farm situated on beautiful Casco Bay, where you will learn how their farmers care for the cows and the land to provide nutrition for their community. You will meet the cows up close and be able to ask all your dairy-related questions. We recommend you wear close-toed shoes and dress for the forecasted weather, as we will be outside. This working farm is also home to one of Maine's most popular campgrounds, an educational children's summer camp, and hosts approximately 30,000 visitors annually, so we ask that you carpool, park at the Smith Center for Education & Research (GPS: 184 Burnett Rd, Freeport, ME), and follow any posted rules around the campus.
